

**NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT OTAGO) NURSERY WORKERS—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Wellington]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand (Except Otago) Nursery Workers' award, dated the 11th day of July, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1075.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 16th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be as follows:—

“ Qualified nurseryman ..	£8 2s. 7d. per week.
“ Qualified casual nurseryman ..	3s. 11d. per hour.
“ Unqualified nurseryman ..	£7 11s. 6d. per week.
“ Labourers ..	£7 2s. 6d. per week.
“ Casual labourers ..	3s. 5d. per hour.”

(2) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Females and Youths) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Females and youths shall be paid not less than the following rates of wages:—

“ Provided that females of the age of eighteen years and upwards shall be paid not less than £2 19s. 6d. per week for the first six months and thereafter according to scale.

“ Provided that youths of the age of eighteen years and upwards shall be paid not less than £3 2s. per week for the first six months, and thereafter according to scale.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
