OAMARU BOROUGH COUNCIL GASWORKS' EMPLOYEES-AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Oamaru Borough Council Gasworks' Employees industrial agreement, made on the 27th day of June, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 1241.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 10th day of March, 1948) shall be further amended by deleting clause 3 and substituting therefor the following clause:—
