CANTERBURY LENDING LIBRARY AND BOOK CLUB EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the Canterbury Lending Library and Book Club Employees' award, dated the 27th day of September, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 1420.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 22nd day of August, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(a) The minimum rate of wages payable to attendants shall be:--
