

**DUNEDIN CITY CORPORATION THEATRICAL CLEANERS AND
CARETAKERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin City Corporation Theatrical Cleaners and Caretakers' industrial agreement, made on the 12th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 84.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a) and (c) of clause 2 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The minimum wages of cleaners shall be £6 17s. 8d. per week.”

“(c) Should any worker be required to work in any capacity in connection with any function other than a dance for which the Concert Chamber or Town Hall is engaged, he shall be paid the sum of 13s. 8d. for time worked between 7 p.m. and 11 p.m., and 3s. 9½d. for extra time worked from 11 p.m. to midnight and 5s. 5d. per hour after midnight. In respect of dances the rate shall be 19s. up to midnight and 5s. 5d. per hour after midnight.”

(2) By deleting subclause (b) of clause 3. (Casual Workers) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(b) Casual workers shall be paid not less than 3s. 5½d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
