

NORTHERN, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY, AND OTAGO AND
SOUTHLAND **PHOTO-ENGRAVERS**—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Photo-Engravers' award, dated the 8th day of March, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 204.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 8 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
