WHAKATANE PAPER MILLS, LTD., AND NEW ZEALAND FOREST PRODUCTS, LTD., WOOD-PULP AND PAPER PRODUCTS WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Whakatane Paper Mills, Ltd., and New Zealand Forest Products, Ltd., Wood-pulp and Paper Products Workers' award, dated the 30th day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1102.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 9 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—
