

**HORN BUTTONS AND ACCESSORIES, LTD., EMPLOYEES—
AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the Horn Buttons and Accessories, Ltd., Employees' award, dated the 19th day of April, 1945, and recorded in 45 Book of Awards 209.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 23rd day of August, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclauses (a), (b), (d), and (e) of clause 7 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Adult male workers, 3s. 5½d. per hour.”

“(b) Adult female workers, £4 8s. 2d. per week.”

“(d) The minimum weekly rates payable to junior male workers shall be:—
