

**DOMINION INDUSTRIES, LTD. (LINSEED PRODUCTS DIVISION),
DUNEDIN, EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL
AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dominion Industries, Ltd. (Linseed Products Division), Dunedin, Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 1st day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2347.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a) and (d) of clause 4 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be:—

“ Factory workers (other than shift-workers)	3	8½
“ Factory shift-workers	3	8½
“ Seed, meal and oil store workers	3	8½

" A shift allowance of 3s. per shift extra shall be paid for shifts worked outside the ordinary hours—8 a.m. to 5 p.m.—provided that when more than eight hours are worked a proportionate amount extra shall be paid according to time worked."

"(d) Female workers may be employed on work agreed upon between the union and the employer at not less than the following rates:—

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
