

**CANTERBURY LAUNDRY WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Canterbury Laundry Workers' award, dated the 8th day of August, 1940, and recorded in 40 Book of Awards 1281.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 27th day of August, 1947) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 5 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—
