KAIKOURA COUNTY COUNCIL POWER-HOUSE EMPLOYEES-AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Kaikoura County Council Powerhouse Employees' award, dated the 16th day of August, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1505.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

"(a) The minimum rates	of	wages	payable	to	workers
under this award shall be:			Per Week.		

- "(i) Senior power-house operator ... 7 6 11
 "Other power-house operators ... 6 19 2
 "(ii) Registered wiremen ... 8 1 4
- "Assistant wiremen ... 7 9 2"

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
