

**UNION STEAM SHIP CO. OF NEW ZEALAND LTD., STEAM-TUG  
MASTERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Union Steam Ship Co. of New Zealand Ltd., Steam-tug Masters' award, dated the 24th day of September, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1691.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting clause 3 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

*“ Wages*

“ 3. The minimum rates of wages shall be:—

	Per Calendar Month.
	£ s. d.
“ Master of s.s. ‘ Taioma ’ .. .. .	46 17 9
“ Master of s.s. ‘ Tapuhi ’ .. .. .	46 17 9”

(2) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Overtime) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) All time worked outside or in excess of the hours prescribed in clause 2 hereof shall be paid for at the rate of 8s. per hour, except time worked on Sundays or holidays, which shall be paid for at the rate of 10s. 9d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
