

DUNEDIN LOCAL BODIES' **MOTOR AND HORSE DRIVERS**—  
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin Local Bodies' Motor and Horse Drivers' award, dated the 29th day of April, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 490.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clauses (a), (b), and (c) of clause 3 (Rates of Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(8) Graders, bulldozers, tractor-shovels over 5/8 cubic yard rated capacity, and rollers (other than steam) in excess of 4 tons weight .. ..	Per Week. £ s. d. 7 19 2

“(10) Nightsoil vehicles: Double ordinary time rates for the vehicle used.	
“(11) A driver when called upon to perform work other than driver's work the time rate for which is lower than £7 3s. 4d. per week shall be paid a minimum rate of ..	7 3 4
“(12) The drivers appointed to attend to lamp-lighting and fencing off jobs outside the ordinary hours of work shall be paid time and a half rate for time so occupied together with tram or bus fares. Time so occupied shall include the time necessary for travelling on tram or bus, and walking-time at three miles an hour, between the tram or bus service and the worker's home and job respectively.	
“(13) Where drivers of household-refuse-collection vehicles are required to assist in loading such vehicles they shall be paid 3d. per hour, with a minimum of 1s. per day, additional.
