

**NEW ZEALAND LIFE ASSURANCE AGENTS, CANVASSERS, AND COLLECTORS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

*[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Wellington]*

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Life Assurance Agents, Canvassers, and Collectors' award, dated the 5th day of March, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 249.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 4 (Rate of Remuneration) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of remuneration to be paid to workers covered by this award shall be £6 14s. 4d. per week.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
