

MARLBOROUGH, NELSON, WESTLAND, AND CANTERBURY
ELECTRICAL WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Christchurch]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Marlborough, Nelson, Westland, and Canterbury Electrical Workers' award, dated the 13th day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1205.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Journeymen registered under the Electrical Wiremen's Registration Act shall be paid a minimum rate of 4s. per hour. Other journeymen shall be paid a minimum rate of 3s. 11d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
