NELSON FREEZING WORKS SHIFT ENGINEERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Nelson Freezing Works Shift Engineers' award, dated the 12th day of May, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 828.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 5 (Salaries) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(a) The rate of salary for workers coming within the scope of this award shall be £598 13s. 4d. per annum, such sum being inclusive of all payments under the Factories Act, 1946."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
