AUCKLAND, WAIKATO, COOK, AND KAIPARA HOSPITAL BOARDS' LAUNDRY EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF INDUS-TRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland, Waikato, Cook, and Kaipara Hospital Boards' Laundry Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 26th day of May, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1510.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made by the union of workers party to the Auckland, Waikato, Cook, and Kaipara Hospital Boards' Laundry Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 26th day of May, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1510, this Court doth hereby order as follows:---

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 14th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting from subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages) the words and figures "Thereafter, £6 18s. 8d. per week," and substituting therefor the words and figures "Thereafter, £7 0s: 7d. per week."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
