

NEW ZEALAND SEAMEN—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Wellington]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Seamen's award, dated the 10th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2913.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this

Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting sub-clause (a) of clause 1 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“ Wages

“(a) The following shall be the rate of wages which shall be paid by the employers respectively to the seamen employed by them respectively, that is to say:—
