

**UNION STEAM SHIP CO. OF NEW ZEALAND, LTD., MARINE
CHIEF STEWARDS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Union Steam Ship Co. of New Zealand, Ltd., Marine Chief Stewards' award, dated the 30th day of April, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 531.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 1 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The rates of wages to be paid per calendar month to chief stewards of passenger-ships, respectively, as herein defined, shall be as follows:—

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
