

**UNION STEAM SHIP CO. OF NEW ZEALAND, LTD., MASTERS
AND OFFICERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Union Steam Ship Co. of New Zealand, Ltd., Masters and Officers' industrial agreement, made on the 30th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2534.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 1 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
