

OTAGO HOSPITAL BOARD **ELECTRICIANS**—AMENDMENT OF
INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Otago Hospital Board Electricians' industrial agreement, made on the 2nd day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1245.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a) and (e) of clause 7 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) The minimum wages of a worker under this agreement shall be £8 per week.”

“(e) A casual worker who is employed for less than forty hours in any one week shall be paid at not less than 4s. per hour.”

2. That this order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
