## MASTERTON MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Masterton Municipal Employees' award, dated the 19th day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1255.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 14th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting from subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) the words and figures "Parks supervisor .. £8 4s. 5d." and substituting therefor the words and figures "Parks supervisor .. £8 6s. 1d."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
