

MARLBOROUGH, NELSON, AND WESTLAND LOCAL BODIES' GARDENERS, LABOURERS, AND OTHER WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

[Filed in the Office of the Clerk of Awards, Nelson]

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Marlborough, Nelson, and Westland Local Bodies' Gardeners, Labourers, and Other Workers' award, dated the 3rd day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2213.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 13th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (c) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(c) All gardeners and plant propagators	Per Week.
shall be paid a minimum weekly wage	£ s. d.
of	7 7 4

Per Hour.

“ Or, if casuals	s. d.
	3 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ ”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
