

AUCKLAND HARBOUR BOARD TUG OFFICERS—AMENDMENT
OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland Harbour Board Tug Officers' industrial agreement, made on the 8th day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1557.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting clause 3 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ Wages

“ 3. The wages shall be at the rate of:—

“ Master ‘ William C. Daldy ’ £668 per annum.

“ Master ‘ Te Awhina ’ .. £585 per annum.

“ Mate ‘ William C. Daldy ’ .. £490 per annum.”
