SANFORD, LTD., AUCKLAND, TRAWLER EMPLOYEES—AMEND-MENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Sanford, Ltd., Auckland, Trawler Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 22nd day of December, 1947, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39c of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the parties to the Sanford, Ltd., Auckland, Trawler Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 22nd day of December, 1947, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting clause 1 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

" Wages

"1. Leading hand on deck (Mate): £8 15s. per week, plus bonus of 3d. per basket marketable fish.

"Deck hands: £8 4s. 2d. per week, plus bonus of 3d. per

basket marketable fish.

"Firemen: £8 4s. 2d. per week, plus bonus of 2d. per basket marketable fish."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
