AUCKLAND, NAPIER, AND TIMARU DREDGEMASTERS—AMEND-MENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Auckland, Napier, and Timaru Dredgemasters' industrial agreement, made on the 1st day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1150.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39c of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the parties to the Auckland, Napier, and Timaru Dredgemasters' industrial agreement, made on the 1st day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1150, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting clause 4 and substituting therefor the following clause:

" Wages

- "4. The wages shall be as follows payable per calendar month:—
 - "Whilst employed as sailing master only at the rate of five hundred and thirty-five pounds (£535) per annum.
 - "Whilst employed as sailing master and dredgemaster, or as sailing master and dredgemaster/ladderman an additional sum at the rate of fifty pounds (£50) per annum."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
