NEW ZEALAND TEA-ROOMS AND RESTAURANT EMPLOYEES-STRIKING OUT PARTIES FROM AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the "Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1925" and its Amendments and in the matter of an Industrial Dispute between the New Zealand Federated Hotel, Restaurant and Related Trades Employees' Industrial Association of "Workers, Applicants, and The Employers listed, Respondents, and in the matter of an application made on behalf of the undermentioned to be struck out as Respondents to the abovementioned Industrial Dispute—(a)Hawke's Bay Farmers' Meat Company Limited, Hastings, (b) Nelsons (N.Z.) Ltd., Hastings. Mr. J. B. Walton for the abovementioned applicants in support of the application made on their behalves.

DECISION OF DEPUTY JUDGE OF THE COURT OF ARBITRATION THERE was no appearance at the Hearing on behalf of the New Zealand Federated Hotel, Restaurant and Related Trades Employees' Industrial Association of Workers to oppose or consent to the application.

The uncontradicted evidence clearly establishes that the applicants do not employ workers coming within the scope of the New Zealand Tea-room and Restaurant Employees' Award dated the 23rd day of December 1948 and recorded in Book of Awards Volume 48 Page 2465, which Award flowed from the Industrial Dispute abovementioned and the applicants were entitled to be struck out as parties as Respondents to such dispute.

To give effect to my view I propose to follow the procedure that I adopted in a similar application by making the following Order pursuant to Section 92 Subsection (a) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1925 amending the Award, that is to say: I do order that the undermentioned shall be and they are hereby deleted as parties to the Tea-room and Restaurant Employees' Award bearing date the 23rd day of December, 1948, and recorded in Book of Awards Volume 48 Page 2465:

- (a) Hawke's Bay Farmers' Meat Company Limited, Hastings.
- (b) Nelsons (N.Z.) Ltd., Hastings.
