WELLINGTON SHIPS' TALLY CLERKS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington Ships' Tally Clerks' industrial agreement, made on the 9th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2383.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by parties to the Wellington Ships' Tally Clerks' industrial agreement, made on the 9th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2383, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 24th May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting the figures and symbols "4s. 1d." in subclause (a) of clause 2 (Wages) and substituting therefor the figures and symbols "4s. $1\frac{1}{2}$ d."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
