

FALCON PLASTICS, LTD., AUCKLAND, FACTORY EMPLOYEES
 —AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Falcon Plastics, Ltd., Auckland, Factory Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 20th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1333.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Falcon Plastics, Ltd., Auckland, Factory Employees' industrial agreement, made on the 20th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1333, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 3rd day of May, 1949) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 8 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rates of wages shall be as follows:—

“ Toolmakers £8 6s. 8d. per week.

“ Tradesmen £8 per week.

“ All other adult males .. £7 7s. 6d. per week.

“ Adult females £4 11s. 6d. per week.

“ Charge hands in charge of three or more other workers shall be paid 7s. 6d. per week extra while so in charge.

“ The definition of ‘toolmaker’ and of ‘tradesman’ shall be as contained in the N.Z. Metal Trades award.”

(2) By deleting the symbols and figures “£4 8s. 2d.” at the end of subclause (c) of clause 8 (Wages) and substituting therefor the symbols and figures “£4 11s. 6d.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
