

GREY ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD ELECTRICAL WORKERS,
LINESMEN, AND ASSISTANTS—AMENDMENT OF INDUS-
TRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Grey Electric-power Board Electrical Workers, Linesmen, and Assistants' industrial agreement, made on the 20th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3289.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39c of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Grey Electric-power Board Electrical Workers, Linesmen, and Assistants' industrial agreement, made on the 20th day of October, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3289, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a), (b), (c), (d), and (e) of clause 2 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Inspectors shall be paid not less than £427 5s. 4d. per annum.

“(b) Technical assistants shall be paid not less than £427 5s. 4d. per annum.

“(c) Troublemens, registered wiremen, servicemen, and linesmen-storemen shall be paid not less than £9 6s. 11d. per week.

“(d) Linesmen shall be paid not less than 4s. 2d. per hour.

“(e) Linesmen's assistants shall be paid not less than 3s. 11½d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
