WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL CLERICAL AND OTHER OFFICERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington City Council Clerical and Other Officers' award, dated the 30th day of September, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2027.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and by the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and upon application made by the parties to the Wellington City Council Clerical and Other Officers' award, dated the 30th day of September, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 2027, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended in the manner following:—
- (1) By deleting paragraph (ii) of subclause (a) of clause 1 (Application of Award) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—
- "(ii) Male officers in receipt of a salary of more than £479 15s. 3d. per annum apart from overtime, and female officers in receipt of a salary of more than £271 per annum apart from overtime."

- (2) By deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 3 (Rates of Remuneration) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—
- "(a) The minimum rates of pay for classified positions shall be those set out in the following Schedule "A":—
