

NEW ZEALAND HOSPITAL BOARDS **METAL TRADESMEN—**  
AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Hospital Boards Metal Tradesmen's award, dated the 24th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3257.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the New Zealand Hospital Boards Metal Tradesmen's award, dated the 24th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3257, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 6th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting sub-clauses (a) and (b) of clause 4 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Except as provided hereunder, all workers covered by this award shall be paid weekly not later than Thursday in each week, and within working hours, a minimum weekly wage of £8 6s. 8d.”

“(b) A worker employed for less than four consecutive weeks shall be deemed a casual and shall be paid at not less than 4s. 2d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
