

CHRISTCHURCH FIRE BRIGADES' OFFICERS—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Christchurch Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 24th day of October, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 849.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the parties to the Christchurch Fire Brigades' Officers' award, dated the 24th day of October, 1944, and recorded in 44 Book of Awards 849, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 9th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended in the manner following:—

(1) By deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Salaries) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum salaries to be paid to the officers coming within the scope of this award shall be as follows:—

(2) By deleting subclause (e) of clause 3.

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
