

**NEW ZEALAND ACTORS AND ACTRESSES—AMENDMENT OF  
AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand Actors and Actresses' award, dated the 3rd day of December, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2529.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf

by parties to the New Zealand Actors and Actresses' award, dated the 3rd day of December, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2529, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclauses (a), (b), (c), (d), (f), and (g) of clause 3 (Rates of Pay) and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—

“(a) Actor: £7 6s. 8d. per week.

“(b) Actress: £6 17s. 6d. per week.

“(c) Male engaged in the chorus or ballet: £6 17s. 8d. per week.

“(d) Female engaged in the chorus or ballet: £6 per week.

“(f) Supernumeraries engaged by the week shall be paid 5s. 6d. for each rehearsal and 6s. 9d. for each performance, with a minimum payment of £2 15s.

“(g) Juvenile Rates:—

“(i) Males—

“(ii) Females—

“ Fourteen years of age and under sixteen years of age	2 12 6
“ Sixteen years of age and under eighteen years of age	4 0 0”

2. That this order shall come into force on the day of the date hereof.
