WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT METER MAKERS AND REPAIRERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Meter Makers and Repairers' award, dated the 5th day of October, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1841.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Wellington Industrial District Meter Makers and Repairers' award, dated the 5th day of October, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1841, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 16th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
 - "(a) Tin-meter makers and/or repairers, 4s. per hour."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
