## WELLINGTON INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT ELECTROPLATERS-AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Wellington Industrial District Electroplaters' award, dated the 18th day of December, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2169.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Wellington Industrial District Electroplaters' award, dated the 18th day of December, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2169; this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 7th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting from clause 5 (Wages) the words and figures "Electroplater with four years' or more experience ...  $3s. 10\frac{1}{2}d$ ." and substituting therefor the words and figures "Electroplater with four years' or more experience ... 3s. 11d."

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
