

NEW ZEALAND (EXCEPT NORTHERN INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT)
CYCLE-WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the New Zealand (except Northern Industrial District) Cycle-workers' award, dated the 2nd day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1197.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the New Zealand (except Northern Industrial District) Cycleworkers' award, dated the 2nd day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1197; this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 13th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 4 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) Except as otherwise provided in subclause (d) of clause 5 hereof, the minimum rate of wages for workers twenty-one years of age and over shall be 3s. 11d. per hour.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
