- NORTHERN, TARANAKI, WELLINGTON, CANTERBURY AND OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND FACTORY ENGINEERS—AMEND-MENT OF AWARD
- In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Factory Engineers' award, dated the 16th day of September, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1613.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Northern, Taranaki, Wellington, Canterbury, and Otago and Southland Factory Engineers' award, dated the 16th day of September, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1613; this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 6th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting from subclause (a) of clause 6 (Wages) the word and figures "Tradesman . . . £7 16s. 8d." and substituting therefore the word and figures "Tradesman . . . £8."
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
