

WHANGAREI BOROUGH COUNCIL CLERICAL AND OTHER OFFICERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Whangarei Borough Council Clerical and Other Officers' industrial agreement, made on the 1st day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1706.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting subclause (m) of clause (4) (Rates of Remuneration) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(m) The following shall be the minimum salaries payable to all employees specified in the following grades:—

“Grade 1.—Except in the case of employees specifically classified, all male employees shall be paid in accordance with the following scale:—
