

DUNEDIN FIRE-BRIGADE OFFICERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin Fire-brigade Officers' award, dated the 25th day of October, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 1574.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf

by the parties to the Dunedin Fire-brigade Officers' award, dated the 25th day of October, 1939, and recorded in 39 Book of Awards 1574; this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 9th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Salaries) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The minimum rate of wages to be paid to the several grades of officers shall be as follows:—

“ Station officers—for the first six months	9 0 3
“ Station officers—thereafter	9 9 3
“ Senior station officers	9 14 3
“ Fourth officer	10 1 3
“ Third officer	10 13 3”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
