## ROYAL NEW ZEALAND AND OTHER AERO CLUBS' EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the Royal New Zealand and Other Aero Clubs' Employees' industrial agreement, dated the 19th day of September, 1946, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 737.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 10th day of September, 1947) shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 2 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
