

**CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL CUSTODIANS AND CLEANERS—AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Christchurch City Council Custodians and Cleaners industrial agreement made on the 6th day of April, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 776.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting clause 3 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ Female cleaners employed at the municipal offices shall be subject to the same working conditions as to hours and holidays as at present obtaining.

“ Coats and overalls with a suitable badge or monogram shall be provided free of cost to the convenience attendants.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
