CHRISTCHURCH TRAMWAY BOARD WORKSHOPS' EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Christchurch Tramway Board Workshops' Employees' award, dated the 19th day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1263.

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39c of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Christchurch Tramway Board Workshops' Employees' award, dated the 19th day of July, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1263, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 1 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—
- "(a) The minimum rates of wages for the undermentioned men in the employ of the Board shall be as follows:—
