**DELEGATION OF POWERS TO NEW ZEALAND HORTICULTURAL AND
GARDENING APPRENTICESHIP COMMITTEE**

PURSUANT to section 14 (1) of the Apprentices Act, 1948, the Court doth hereby delegate to the New Zealand Horticultural and Gardening Apprenticeship Committee, registered on the 4th day of August, 1948, all the powers conferred on it by paragraphs (a), (f), (g), (h), (k), and (l) of subsection (4) of section 13 and by section 33 of the said Act, in so far as those powers relate to the industry in respect of which the Committee has been appointed—namely, the horticultural and gardening industry—but reserving, nevertheless, power to the Court at any time to revoke or vary such delegation.
