NORTH ISLAND BRICK, TILE, AND POTTERY WORKERS—AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942; and in the matter of the North Island Brick, Tile, and Pottery Workers' award dated the 3rd day of April, 1940 and recorded in 40 Book of Awards 225 (in force in respect of the Taranaki Industrial District only).

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations, 1942, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, this Court, for the purpose of giving effect to the pronouncement made by it on the 12th day of April, 1949, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 12th day of September, 1947), shall be further amended by deleting subclauses (a) and (b) of clause 3 (Wages), and substituting therefor the following subclauses:—
