

OTAGO AND SOUTHLAND **CANISTER-WORKERS**—AMENDMENT
OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Otago and Southland Canister-workers' award, dated the 19th day of October, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1912.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf

by the union of workers party to the Otago and Southland Canister-workers' award, dated the 19th day of October, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1912, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 14th day of May, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting from subclause (b) of clause 4 (Employment of Females) the symbols and figures “£4 10s.” and substituting therefor the symbols and figures “£4 13s. 4d.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 9th day of November, 1949.
