

DUNEDIN METROPOLITAN FIRE BOARD **ELECTRICIANS**—  
AMENDMENT OF INDUSTRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Dunedin Metropolitan Fire Board Electricians' industrial agreement, made on the 28th day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1886.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the parties to the Dunedin Metropolitan Fire Board Electricians' industrial agreement, made on the 28th day of June, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 1886, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement shall be amended by deleting clause 5 and substituting therefor the following clause:—

“ 5. *Wages*

“ The minimum rates of wages shall be £8 13s. 4d. per week.”

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
