

**INVERCARGILL FIRE-BRIGADE EMPLOYEES—AMENDMENT OF
AWARD**

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942; and in the matter of the Invercargill Fire-brigade Employees' award, dated the 15th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3001.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the union of workers party to the Invercargill Fire-brigade Employees' award, dated the 15th day of December, 1947, and recorded in 47 Book of Awards 3001, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award (as amended by order of the Court dated the 9th day of May, 1949), shall be further amended by deleting subclause (a) of clause 3 (Wages) and substituting therefor the following subclause:—

“(a) The following shall be the minimum rates of wages:—

2. That this order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of June, 1949.
