NEW ZEALAND FIRE BRIGADES' SUPERINTENDENTS AND DEPUTY SUPERINTENDENTS'—AMENDMENT OF INDUS-TRIAL AGREEMENT

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand.—In the matter of the Economic Stabilization Regulations 1950; and in the matter of the New Zealand Fire Brigades' Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents' industrial agreement, made on the 6th day of September, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2109.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by Regulation 39A of the Economic Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1942, and upon application made in that behalf by the parties to the New Zealand Fire Brigades' Superintendents and Deputy Superintendents' industrial agreement, made on the 6th day of September, 1948, and recorded in 48 Book of Awards 2109, which application was filed herein on the 23rd day of February, 1950, this Court doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said industrial agreement (as amended by order of the Court dated the 29th day of July, 1949) shall be further amended by deleting clause 2 and substituting therefor the following clause :---

"2. Salary Payments
