AUCKLAND TRANSPORT BOARD'S MAINTENANCE OFFICERS—AMENDMENT

Upon reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Auckland Transport Board's Maintenance Officers' award, dated the 16th day of December, 1949, and recorded in 49 Book of Awards 3884, the Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. That subclause (a) of clause 2 of the said award shall be amended by deleting the rates of wages for workshop foremen and electrician-in-charge and substituting therefor "£10 3s. 8d." and "£9 12s. 8d." respectively.
- 2. That this order shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 12th day of April, 1950.
