DUNEDIN LOCAL BODIES' LABOURERS-AMENDMENT OF AWARD

In the Court of Arbitration of New Zealand, Otago and Southland Industrial District.—In the matter of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and its amendments; and in the matter of the Dunedin Local Bodies' Labourers' award, dated the 5th day of December, 1950, and recorded in 50 Book of Awards 1953.

UPON reading the joint application of the parties for amendment of the Dunedin Local Bodies' Labourers' award, dated the 5th day of December, 1950, this Court, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by section 92 (1) (c) of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, and with the consent of the parties, doth hereby order as follows:—

1. That the said award shall be amended by deleting the penultimate paragraph of the schedule in subclause (b) of clause (2), and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

"Drainage Board gangers shall be paid £8 11s. per week, but shall not be entitled to any of the special payments set out in the above provisions of this clause."

2. That this order shall operate and take effect as from the day of the date hereof.
